When England's Dusty Springfield met America's Bobby Vee recently, she amazed him by naming the capital of North Dakota, his home state.

The blond, green-eyed Dusty, who has made just a few brief visits to the United States, can draw freehand a U.S. map, with boundaries, names and capitals of states in all the right places; discuss the America Indian tribes; explain the strategies of the Civil War, and expound on American history better than most native-born Yankees.

Dusty also has other talents: a singing talent so great that its universal appeal has just won for her a coveted listing in *Billboard's* "100 Top International Artists"—and in addition, in the past year, Dusty has been ranked at the top of every poll naming most popular newcomers to the recording scene, most promising new vocalists, and best new artists, appearing in the trade press, consumer magazines, teen and fan publications. With her own avid interest in America, it's no wonder that the young singer has become one of this country's favorite and best-selling vocalists.

Dusty is known as a genuine "kook"—a title she has earned simply by being her own, natural, uninhibited self. For Dusty has an infectious, wry sense of humor that enables her to laugh

at the world—and at herself.

When Dusty is angry or just plain fed up, she doesn't brood, or take out her frustrations on friends or family. Instead, she hies herself to the dime-store, buys a set of the cheapest china dishes she can find, and gives the whole set a heave down the nearest corridor. "Oh, it makes a lovely sound!" says Dusty, her green eyes gleaming impishly.

Dusty has the distinction of having begun her career in the first English group to make it big with American record fans—The Springfield's, in which she performed with her brother and a friend.

On her own, Dusty has had a string of hit singles, plus two best-selling Philips albums. On this new album, Dusty shows her wide range of vocal talent. She switches easily and effectively from blues to ballads to music with a beat. There is a distinct "bluesy" flavor to much of Dusty's singing, for to her, the quality called soul is essential to good music.

Perhaps it is this quality of soul, this ability of Dusty's to put her feelings so vitally into her singing, that makes this new album of songs about love such an exciting experience.
